SUBJECT: CEMENT MASONS 2025-2028 MASTER LABOR AGREEMENT

Effective July 1, 2026, in accordance with the Cement Masons Master Labor Agreement, there will be an increase to be allocated as follows:

Wage rates for all classifications will be the same as for commercial, excluding public work projects.

MILITARY BASES

For work performed at Vandenberg Air Force Base, Point Arguello, Point Conception, China Lake, Camp Roberts, Edwards Air Force Base, North Edwards Air Force Base, Naval Ordnance Test Station, Marine Corp. Supply, Fort Irvine, George Air Force Base, Naval Air Facility, El Centro and (for jobs bid after July 1, 1988) 29 Palms Marine Base the differential will remain at \$2.00 per hour in lieu of subsistence.

MACHINE RATE

Effective 7/1/2025 - To be paid \$1.00 above Journeyman scale

FOREMAN RATE

The foreman shall be paid not less than \$3.00 an hour more than the hourly Cement Mason Journeyman rate

GENERAL FORMAN RATE

The General Foreman shall be paid not less than \$4.00 an hour than the hourly Cement Mason Journeyman rate.

AERIAL BOOM PLATFORMS, SUSPENDED OR FIXED SCAFFOLD

\$1.00 per hour the applicable rate

SUBSISTANCE

Effective 7/1/2025 - \$75.00 per day for work on the Off-Shore Islands Only.

*Please note the following improvements and language clarifications to staggered starts and Saturday makeup days that were negotiated for the new 2011-2014 agreement. (~~Strikeout~~ indicates deletions and **bold** indicates additions.)*

Article XVI, section 1602.2 – Special shifts – Amend as follows:

“The starting time of single shifts shall be 5:00 A.M., 5:30 A.M., 6:00 A.M., 6:30 A.M., 7:00 A.M., 7:30 A.M., or 8:00 A.M., Monday through Sunday. Starting times may be changed to meet job requirements, including maximum utilization of daylight hours. Staggered starts may be implemented ~~but will be no more than~~ **within two (2) hours after the initial start time, and up to four (4) hours, if approved through Work Recovery, which request may be submitted at any time, either before or during the course of the project.** All employees assigned to staggered starts are guaranteed their full shift. Twenty-four (24) hour notice shall be given to the Union, in cases of deviation from the original starting time.”
