SUBJECT: OPERATING ENGINEERS 2025-2028
CONCRETE PUMPERS MASTER LABOR AGREEMENT

Effective January 1, 2026, in accordance with the Operating Engineers Local 12 a reallocation of Vacation-Holiday funds monies to Health & Welfare will take place.

New rates for all fringe benefits are as follows:

*Vacation/Supplemental Dues are added to the hourly wage rate to establish the gross pay for tax purposes. This gross amount is subject to normal payroll deductions. After normal deductions, the full Vacation/Supplemental dues contribution is deducted, reported and paid to the appropriate Trust Fund.

**The Group 8 wage rate shall be fifty cents (\$0.50) above the Group 7 wage rate.

When special single shifts are worked, the straight time rate of all Groups shall be Three Dollars and Fifty cents (\$3.50) per hour above the straight time rate of the classification performing the work.

APPRENTICE WAGE RATES

Based on the Journeyman scale of Group II per hour

0-1000	Hours - Step I	@60%
1001-2000	Hours - Step II	@65%
2001-3000	Hours - Step III	@70%
3001-4000	Hours - Step IV	@75%
4001-5000	Hours - Step V	@80%
5001-6000	Hours - Step VI	@90%

All shift pay or premiums entitled to be paid under the terms of this agreement shall be paid in full and added to the Apprentice Base Wage Rate, for all hours worked or paid.

At no time shall the above apprentice wage rates exceed any of the Journeyman Group Rates of this agreement.

Effective July 1, 2025, it was agreed in negotiations employees required to suit up and work in a **hazardous material environment** shall receive Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour in addition to their regular rate of pay.

Effective July 1, 2022, in the event the Operator or Apprentice is Required to travel in excess of fifty (50) miles from the Contractor's yard, he shall be *provided a safe and sanitary room and reimbursed up to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for food per day* when the equipment in question remains on the job for further operation at the conclusion of the day *and in the event an overnight stay is required*.

Effective July 1, 2019, it was agreed in negotiations the tool allowance for all Heavy-Duty Repairmen or Heavy Duty Repairman – Welder Combinations will be increased from fifty cents (\$0.50) to One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour.

Effective July 1, 2019, it was agreed in negotiations that the additional pay for the Foreman will be increased from One Dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) to Two Dollars (\$2.00).

Effective September 30, 2013, the subsistence rate will be Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) per scheduled workday.

This agreement expires June 30, 2028
