Pipeline & Underground Committee The Pipeline and Underground Committee (P.U.G.) protects, educates, and supports excavation workers, with a focus on Dig Alert, damage prevention, and safe digging in California. Collaborating with the Underground Safety Board and legislative committees, P.U.G. keeps members informed and addresses regulations impacting field professionals.
Political Action Committee Our Political Action Committee (PAC) operates to build our Association's relationships with candidates at the state and local levels, serves as a tool to strengthen our Association's governmental affairs activities, and allows SCCA's voice to be heard. Contributions that are given to the local and state candidates are approved by our PAC Chair and members. All contributions are recorded pursuant to the California Elections Code and the California Political Reform Act. Our PAC retains a Certified Public Accountant who specializes in campaign contributions to ensure compliance with the state and local laws.
Programs Committee Our Programs Committee plans and oversees the formal and informal events hosted by SCCA. Some duties performed by this committee are setting the annual event calendar, selecting venues, building budgets for each event, and works closely with SCCA staff to create memorable events that assist our members in building relationships.
Safety Committee Our Safety Committee meets regularly to share updates regarding safety information including but not limited to new and changed legal and regulatory requirements. Our members are encouraged by the Safety Committee to attend its meetings which serve as an open forum to share and discuss best practices in the construction industry. The committee also recognizes best safety practices annually by hosting an awards dinner for all members who demonstrate zero to minimal incidents throughout the year.
Scholarship Committee The Scholarship Committee oversees our Association's Scholarship Fund which awards financial scholarships to students who are pursuing construction or engineering-oriented degrees or certification at accredited schools. Our Scholarship Committee encourages our recipients to seek employment with one or our Association's members upon graduation.
State & Local Legislative Committee Our State and Local Legislative Committee supports our Association through monitoring several hundred bills at the state level each year that could potentially affect our members and the construction industry. The Committee also educates our members regarding these issues and takes an active stance on proposed bills to either help pass or defeat legislation at the state level. This Committee has two Subcommittees which are the Subcommittee on Local Government Affairs (SOLGA) and the Subcommittee on Transportation Policy (STP). These Subcommittees identify opportunities to create strategic partnerships with counties, cities, and regulatory agencies. These partnerships provide invaluable forums for our members as well as educate policymakers on how their decisions impact our members and our industry.
